Comparing the Mareh and Chazown

Mareh – Daniel 8:20-25 (Horizontal Conquests)

²⁰ The ram which thou sawest having two horns are the kings of Media and Persia.

²¹ And the rough goat is the king of Grecia: and the great horn that is between his eyes is the first king.

²² Now that being broken, whereas four stood up for it, four kingdoms shall stand up out of the nation, but not in his power.

²³ And in the latter time of their kingdom, when the transgressors are come to the full, a king of fierce countenance, and understanding dark sentences, shall stand up.

²⁴ And his power shall be mighty, but not by his own power: and he shall destroy wonderfully, and shall prosper, and practise, and shall destroy the mighty and the holy people.

²⁵ And through his policy also he shall cause craft to prosper in his hand; and he shall magnify himself in his heart, and by peace shall destroy many: he shall also stand up against the **Prince of princes**; but he shall be broken without hand.

The Mareh deals with the ram, goat, little horn (horizontal), and the Price broken.

Chazown (about the 'daily) - Daniel 8:10-14

- Trampled host
- Removal of the 'daily', subverts the ministry of Jesus Christ
- Place of sanctuary is thrown down
- Host given over to the horn
- The 'daily' given to the horn
- Truth flung to the ground and prospered
- Host and Holy Place trampled
- 2,300 evening and mornings (days)
- Holy Place restored

The Chazown deals with the little horn (vertical), stars fall/trampled/given to horn, magnifies to be equal to Commander of host, removes the daily, and how long to allow both the Holy Place and host to be trampled. None of the elements of the 'daily' are in the *Mareh'*, that is the key point.

In Daniel 8:27, we find Daniel astounded at the vision...the Mareh'. He sees the Prince of princes broken...the crucifixion of Christ.

Daniel see what the 'little horn' does to the daily, the attack upon heaven and Christ's system of salvation.
